## Halloween Fun Facts

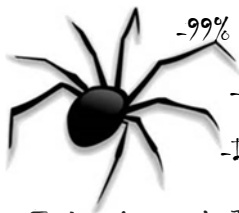


-Trick-or-treating dates back to the Middle Ages and All Soul's Day, when poor people in Britain would beg for soul cakes, a sweet-bread treat, and pray for dead relatives in return.

-When trick-or-treating first became popular in the US in the 1800's, more children played mischievous pranks than asked for candy.

-The candy-collecting tradition has spread from the United States to Canada, Australia, and Western Europe, where more and more little goblins now trick-or-treat. In parts of England, children carry lanterns called punkies (which look like jack-o'-lanterns) and parade through the town on the last Thursday of October. In Ireland, rural neighborhoods light bonfires, and children play snap apple, in which they try to take a bite from apples that are hung by strings from a tree or a door frame.

-Both Salem, MA and Anoka, MN are the self-proclaimed Halloween capitals of the world.



-99% of all pumpkins sold in the US are used as Jack-o'-Lanterns for Halloween.

-More candy is sold on October 28th than any other day of the year.

-In Hollywood there's a \$1,000 fine for using Silly String on Halloween.



-To date the most lit Jack-o'-Lantern's displayed world record is held by Keene, NH. They displayed 30,581 on October 19, 2013.

-The first recorded haunted attraction was the Orton and Spooner Ghost House, which opened in 1915 in the United Kingdom as part of an Edwardian fair.

-Disney's Haunted Mansion opened in 1969. Originally, guests were supposed to walk through the Mansion, but the park staff had problems maintaining their pace & keeping the line moving along. So it became a dark ride in which guests sat in trains (known as "Doom Buggies") that carried them through the Mansion.

-It takes an average of 252 to 364 licks to get to the center of a Tootsie Pop.
