POLICY ANNOUNCEMENT

Parking permits for Sunnyside Apartments expire each year on September 30th, be sure to renew your SUNNY parking permits before that date. Parking Permits may be purchased online at <u>commuterservices.utah.edu</u> by the primary resident in family apartments and by each resident in graduate housing.

A license plate recognition system is used to identify vehicles that have permission to park at Sunnyside Apartments. Park so that your license plate is visible from the roadway. Do not back into parking stalls if you do not have a license plate on the front of your vehicle. Residents can purchase temporary permissions for visitors through Commuter Services.
