Policy Reminders

Garbage and Recycling Policy

We appreciate your help in keeping our community clean and eco-friendly. Here are a few reminders about the Garbage and Recycling Policy.

Avoid contaminating blue recycling bins/chutes with non-recyclable items, as contaminated bins are treated as trash and sent to the landfill.

Glass is not accepted in recycling dumpsters and must be dropped off at approved glass recycling sites throughout Salt Lake City. For a list of recyclable and non-recyclable items please see the Garbage and Recycling Policy in the Resident Handbook.

Cedar Buildings – Do not leave donations, household items, trash, furniture or other items outside the dumpsters. Anything left outside the dumpsters will be disposed of. For large items (furniture), use the large dumpster north of the Maintenance Building in the West Village.

Cottonwood and Spruce Buildings - Garbage and recyclables must be separated properly before using the chutes. Recyclables must be left loose and not in garbage sacks. If the chute doors are locked, another resident may be using the chute on another floor, please wait for it to become available. Break down any cardboard boxes and take them to the blue recycle dumpster in the first-floor trash room.
