America's Test Kitchen Simple Cranberry Sauce

3/4 Cup Water

1 Cup Granulated Sugar

1/4 tsp Salt

12 oz. Bag of Cranberries (About
3 Cups)

In a medium saucepan over high heat, bring water, sugar, and salt to a boil.

Stir in cranberries; return to boil.

Reduce heat to medium; simmer until slightly thickened, saucy, and about 2/3 of the cranberries have popped open, about 5 to 6 minutes. Transfer to a serving bowl, cool to room temperature, and serve.
